## Ch 4: What is Creation?

- What is the Doctrine of Creation?
- What is the Created Creation? God created the universe out of nothing (Latin: ex nihilo); nothing but God existed before the universe was created.
- Gen 1:1, Job 33:4, Col 1:16
- Heb 11:3 says, "By faith, we understand that the universe was created by the word of God so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible."
- Rom 1:17 says, "...calls into existence the things that do not exist."
- God spoke all of creation into existence except humans He created with His hands. (Gen 2:7,22). Ps 139:13
- What does it mean to be an image bearer of God? (Gen 1:27).
- God is not just a distant Creator but intimately involved in His creation. Acts 17:28
- What are the wrong views of the earth:
  - Materialism
  - Pantheism
  - Dualism
  - o <u>Deism</u>
- God Deserves Glory. Rev 4:11, Jer. 10:12
- What is the age of the Earth?
- Some possible suggestions (there is room for disagreement among Christians):
  - There is a possibility that God created a "grown up" universe.
  - There is a possibility of a break b/w Gen 1:1 and 1:2.
  - There is a possibility of a break b/w between 1:2 and 1:3.
  - There is a possibility of a long day in Gen 1.

- There is a possibility that the flood affected the geological data.
- o The use of the word "kinds" in Gen 1 may be quite broad.
- There is a possibility of the death of animals before the fall.
- Where the Hebrew word bara is not used, there is the possibility of a sequence from previously existing things.
- o **Old Earth theory:** Gen 2:4, Gen 1:5, Gen 1:14-19, 2 Peter 3:8.

- Young Earth theory: Ex 20:8-11
- Secular theory
- Theistic evolution (or evolutionary creation) Gen 1-3, 1 Cor 15:47, Rom 1:20
