- There are three other kinds of heavenly beings.

 - 3. The Living Creatures: Ezekiel 1:5-14; Revelation 4:6-8.
- There is rank and order among angels. Jude 9, Daniel 10:13, Revelation 12:7-8, 1 Thessalonians 4:16, Daniel 8:16, 9:21, Luke 1:19, 26-27, Luke 1:26, Deuteronomy 33:2, Psalms 68:17, Hebrews 12:22 Revelation 5:11.

Galatians 4:8 There have been differing stages of demonic activity in the history of redemption: Deuteronomy 32:16-17, Psalms 106:35-37, 1 Corinthians 10:20, Mark 1:27, Matthew 12:28-29, Matthew 10:8, Acts 8:7; 16:18; James 4:7; 1 Peter 5:8-9, 1 John 3:8). • Satan: Luke 10:18, Matthew 4:1, Genesis 3:1, Matthew 10:25, Ephesians 2:2, Matthew 13:19, 1 John 3:8, 2 Corinthians 4:4).
